

## SMALL SERGED BAG (tie-on and tie off)



### SUPPLIES

11½" X 6" outer fabric\*

13" X 6" lining fabric\*

\*Any size bag can be made, this is just the size I chose. Always cut the lining about 1½" longer than the outer fabric so a little bit shows.

### INSTRUCTIONS

Set up serger for 4-thread overlock; Stitch Width 5.5, Stitch Length 2.5.

Serge short ends of the two fabrics, right sides together. There will be excess fabric in middle.

Turn right-side out and smooth down so that a bit of the lining shows at each end as shown in the picture. (Like tissue holders.) >>>



With outer fabric facing up, turn down the top 1½" as shown here.



Next turn up the bottom portion to about ¾" from the top; pin through all layers and prepare to serge.

Serge side seams, using the tie-on and tie-off technique.



Turn right side out - like a flip-top sandwich bag - and fill with a little surprise!
