Freestanding Lace Embroidery

Battenburg lace designs are embroidered onto water-soluble stabilizer. When the stabilizer is soaked away, beautiful lace remains behind.

The design file used for this session is from S-Embroidery.com.

Project Needs & Notes


• Water-soluble stabilizer

(i.e., Vilene, OESD Aquamesh)

- 30-35 weight cotton thread (may use polyester thread) Bobbin Thread MUST Match Top Thread
- Size 11 or 75/11 sharp sewing needle

Instructions

• Wind Four (4) bobbins to match upper thread.



Instructions

- Hoop up with two layers of woven Wash Away stabilizer on a 5 x 7 or larger hoop.
- Important: Only make one design per hoop because you need to make sure nothing moves.


Stitch out 4 Designs, One at a Time

- Stitch out the first design.
- Remove from hoop.
- Stitch design a total of four times to complete your circle.



Lay Each piece the same as they were in the hoop

- When completed, cut around the designs and soak in water until the Wash Away stabilizer is gone.
- It's now time to stitch them together.
- It is best to keep each piece laying the same as it was in the hoop. This way you won't get confused.



Refer to Instructions when Stitching the Pieces Together

- Refer to the stitch out pictures and any instructions included with the design.
- A close up of where to stitch is also included. I did these by hand.







Completed Design

- When complete, lay the finished piece on top of your chosen fabric and pin in place.
- You will then zig zag all around the inside edge. I used a width of 2.5 and length of 1.2 to stitch mine on.
- When completed, cut around the zig zag stitches and trim away excess fabric.




Cookie jar is a design in Floriani software. Made the cookies to use as coasters on the table.


